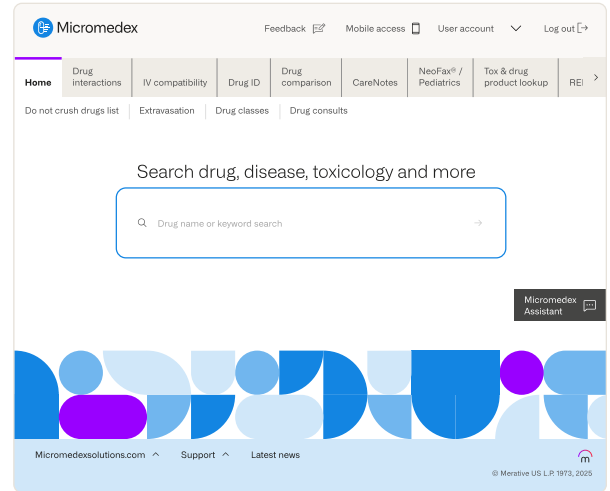

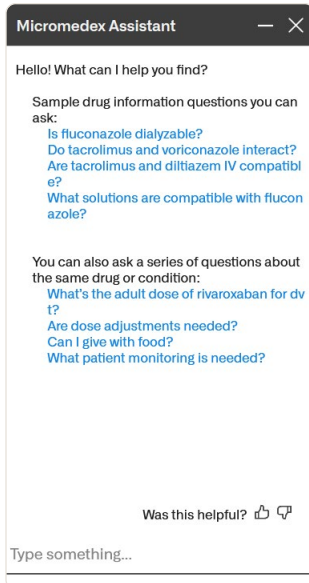
Micromedex Assistant and keyword search

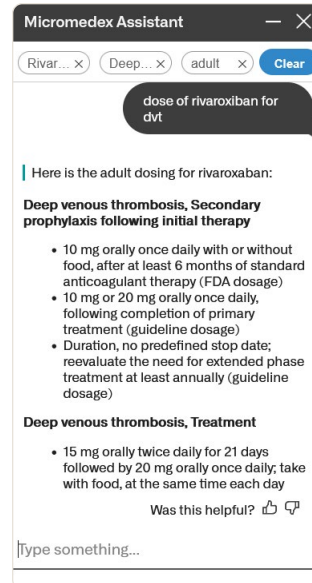


Open the Micromedex Assistant directly from your homepage

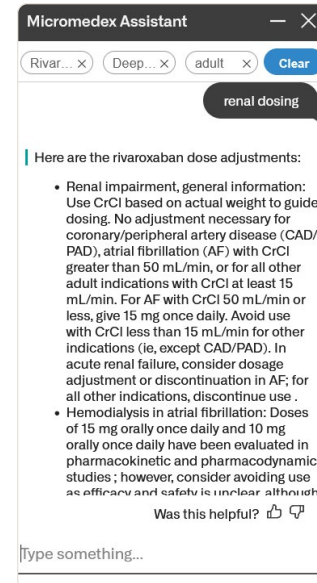
1. Ask a question.

3. Get the answer.

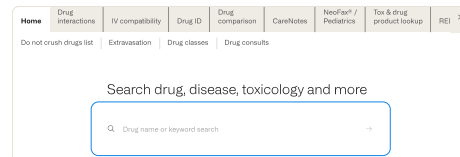


More sample questions the Micromedex Assistant can answer:

Can I crush ditropan?	Interaction coumadin and aspirin	Drugs that treat [condition]	Side effect effects of caffeine	Pediatric dose of augmentin for otitis
Trade name for [drug]?	Drug class of bactroban	Is [drug] safe in pregnancy	Pediatric FDA approved use for [drug]	Is [drug] compatible with D5W
Can I push ancef?	Monitoring for lasix	ADRs for [drug]	BBW [drug]	Monitoring for [drug]

Micromedex with keyword search

Use the keyword search when you have general questions or want to read about a drug or condition.



Search term/phrase	Description
[YYYYY]	Search by specific year (1995->). Returns the Drug Consult on drugs approved in that year. To see all: search on 'new drug approvals.
Acronyms	Returns the Drug Consult, Chemotherapy Acronyms and Dosing with Alphabetical list of Chemotherapy acronyms and dosing regimens. Can also search specific regimens
ABVD	Returns drug consult, ABVD – Used for Hodgkin’s disease chemotherapy regimen.
Clinical approach to	Returns links to toxin-induced disease states (e.g., Hyperthermia, Hypotension).
Chemotherapy	Returns drug consults such as chemotherapy dosing in obese patients, chemotherapy and radiotherapy treatment guidelines for nausea and vomiting and others.
Drugs that treat aspergillosis	Returns drugs that treat aspergillosis based on efficacy rating. Try 'drugs that treat' for other indications.
Drugs that cause hyperkalemia	Returns a list of drugs associated with hyperkalemia. Click on ' T ' & choose tacrolimus; see tacrolimus adverse effects. Under serious, endocrine: view incidence for hyperkalemia. For more detailed evidence on this ADR, click in-depth answers, endocrine/metabolic, hyperkalemia.
Guidelines	Returns an extensive list of drug consults summarizing treatment guidelines covering infectious diseases, cardiovascular, neurologic, immunologic, endocrine/metabolic, and more.
Drug interactions* (include * as wild card)	Returns list of individual drug consults reviewing specific inhibitors, inducers, and substrates.
Opioid	Returns list of drugs in the opioid class.
Opioid* (include * as wild card)	Filter all results by drug. Returns drug consults focused on treatment of pain, opioid-induced constipation, opioid withdrawal, and others.
Extravasation	Returns results that include drug consults, cytotoxic drug extravasation therapy and non-cytotoxic drug extravasation therapy.
Beers	Returns drug consult, beers criteria-a summary of potentially inappropriate medication use among the elderly. Try searching stop to access START/STOP drug consult.
AHA	Filter all results by drug. Returns drug consults covering a variety of guidelines from the AHA. Try 'CDC', 'IDSA', 'ACCP', 'ACR'.
Mobile apps	Passwords are found under the mobile application access section on the home page. Passwords for the NeoFax® and pediatrics apps are found in the NeoFax application, under mobile at the top right of the display.
