Content Highlights for 2023

The complexity of drug therapy continues to increase, and we understand that keeping up with evidence to make informed decisions becomes more and more challenging with every passing year. The Micromedex team is committed to providing you with the latest, most accurate clinical information to reflect evolving evidence and practice, tailored to support patient safety across your specific patient populations. Below are the highlights of 2023 content updates:

New drug approvals

We've expanded our database to include detailed information on 100 newly approved drugs, ensuring healthcare professionals have access to the latest pharmaceutical developments.

Professional drug content

- Expansion of off-label uses, evidence summaries, and dosing
 - Added over 160 new off-label uses and supporting evidence summaries
- Enhancement of end-organ dose adjustment recommendations
 - Updated renal and hepatic dose adjustment recommendations for over 230 drugs
- Augmentation of drug interactions content and management recommendations
 - Augmented nearly 400 drugs with pharmacogenomic- and enzyme-mediated drug interactions and supporting evidence



- P&T Quik is currently bundled into a Formulary subscription and is not orderable separately






