



Tox & Drug Product Lookup

Search Options

- Conduct most searches from the Products and Substances search tab, including searches for drugs, commercial products, substances, slang terms, AAPCC codes and more.
- Use the Martindale Global Drug search tab to look up international drugs. Please note that Martindale is third-party content provided for informational purposes and does not have product or AAPCC codes.
- Use the Company Contacts search tab to access contact information for drug manufacturers.



AAPCC Code Lookup



1. Utilize the AAPCC Code Lookup link (from the main Tox & Drug Product Lookup page) to access a full list of AAPCC codes and definitions. Search by code or by keyword to find all results containing your search term.
2. Copy your desired code and return to the Tox & Drug Product Lookup

- Paste your results into the search bar and select the word-wheel drop down that includes (AAPCC) to perform a search for all results that are associated with this code. Please note that these searches may take some time, as some codes have many search results affiliated with them.

Viewing Search Results

- Choose from a List view, or Preview pane view via the View Page toggle on the right side above the results.
- Preview allows users to access details about each search result and directly link out to managements or drug evaluations for more information.
- List gives users a listing of all search results, and the user may then click additional links to learn more.
- The system will remember your preferred view for your next session. You may change your selection at any time.




Word Wheel

The Word Wheel is a great way to refine your search results before you hit enter. This is especially helpful when there are a lot of generic products available for that active ingredient (eg, Acetaminophen).

1. Enter the search term into the box and options will appear below the box as you type.



2. You can then scroll through the Word Wheel results until you find the one you want. Select your product from here, and you will be shown only relevant results:



Please note that if you try to select an option in the Word Wheel and you receive this error message, it is likely a timing issue. Poisindex Products are updated every week, and it takes a while to refresh all the data.

Expert Tip: Try using **Ctrl F** to do a keyword search within the Word Wheel results!





AAPCC Code or Product ID Searches

You will need to use the Word Wheel to do a search for a specific AAPCC Code or Product ID. If you type in the Code and immediately hit enter, you will get the following message.

But you will get a valid result if you select the code from the Word Wheel:

Emergent Codes


Searching for the specific Product ID is especially helpful with Emergent Codes, which are immediately available for coding but may not have a title yet (due to deliverable timing).



Feedback

Use the Feedback button, found on the right-side of the page throughout the product, to submit thoughts or ideas to the Micromedex team, including requests to add new products.

- Results are reviewed daily by the Micromedex Product and Editorial teams. Frequently, you will find that items you request to add to Micromedex can be found in the system within a week. More complicated requests may take longer to address.


Content Highlights

Generic Entries

These may be listed in the results in ALL CAPS or Mixed Case. It's okay to use either one. Generic entries can be easily identified in the search results by the absence of an Active Ingredient, Physical Description, and Company.

Group Documents

Please note that generic entries should **not** be used if they are for a group document. The title of these group documents usually contains "and related agents" or a plural name (eg, Benzodiazepines).



Search Tip: Type in the product name first, not the generic name (if you are looking for something specific)

Poisindex Managements

- Patient Disposition – this section contains the key triage and threshold information to help end-users disseminate the information and make quick decisions.
- Patient Disposition summaries are being added to the **Treatment Overview** section, for quicker reference. This is an ongoing initiative.

Note: Summary sections of the monographs do not contain references. Full references can be found within the expanded content sections of the monograph.

0.4.2 ORAL/PARENTERAL EXPOSURE

A) MANAGEMENT OF MILD TO MODERATE TOXICITY

1) Treatment is symptomatic and supportive

B) MANAGEMENT OF SEVERE TOXICITY

1) Treat hypotension with intravenous fluids, add vt benzodiazepines initially.

L) PATIENT DISPOSITION

1) IMMEDIATE CRITERIA: Asymptomatic adult with an inadvertent ingestion of an extra dose can be managed at home. Asymptomatic children with inadvertent ingestions of up to 200 mg can be managed at home.

2) OBSERVATION CRITERIA: Symptomatic patients, those with deliberate ingestions, and children ingesting more than 200 mg should be referred to a healthcare facility.

IMMEDIATE RELEASE: Patients ingesting an immediate release product should be observed for approximately 4 to 6 hours (peak plasma levels occur about 1 hour after dosing when taken on an empty stomach or 2 hours after dosing when taken with food). EXTENDED RELEASE: Patients ingesting an extended-release preparation should be observed for 12 to 16 hours (Tmax is 9 hours at a therapeutic dose of extended release trazodone (300 mg)).

3) ADMISSION CRITERIA: Patients with cardiac toxicity, persistent hypotension, seizures, or with CNS depression that persists after 12 hours of observation should be admitted.

4) CONSULT CRITERIA: Consult a medical toxicologist for assistance with medical management if the patient develops more than moderate symptoms or if the symptoms are not consistent with a trazodone exposure.

Other Tips & Tricks

- Micromedex recommends using the internet to access our system, versus the intranet. Benefits of the internet include fast search capability, access to the latest published content, and the ability to submit Feedback to Micromedex from within your workflow.
- Type 'Drugs that cause ...' or 'Drugs that treat ...' in the main search bar on the Micromedex homepage to get a list of results that may help narrow down the drug you're looking for.
- Export your search results: You can use "Export Search Results As" to save your search in a CSV or XLS file:
