Direct launch of Merge PACS on cloud — Allows Merge PACS viewer to be launched in the cloud directly from within the Merge PACS Workstation.

Merge Workflow Orchestrator integrations support bringing selected details from MWO into Merge PACS.

#### FEATURES AND BENEFITS

Multiple presentation states per study — Supports the creation and management of multiple study presentations within a study. Users are now able to create separate presentation states for different purposes (diagnosis, conference, etc.).



Thumbnail preference — This convenience feature highlights the series on the thumbnail bar as users navigate. This could become distracting for studies with many seris. The new preference allows users to select if the thumbnail bar automatically displays the image on the active viewport.

Unviewed Image warning — Provides two separate "Warn user when images are not viewed prior to setting of status" privileges to allow users to select different options for mammography and other studies for additional flexibility.




Viewing Improvements:

- All viewports are displayed at largest common zoom factor for consistent viewing.


#### Merge PACS v8 Mammography Display:

Standard CC & MLO views — Allows users to display the selected view (current CC or current MLO) for mammography in 2X1 layout without configuration.



Mammography workflow improvements:

- Creates a new "Automatically Stack/Scroll MG Priors for DBT" to support different preference between 2D and DBT priors.
- Supports additional configuration to include ML view into MLO Prior/Stack Scrolling.


